Celebration of Manipuri Language Day on 20th August, 2016



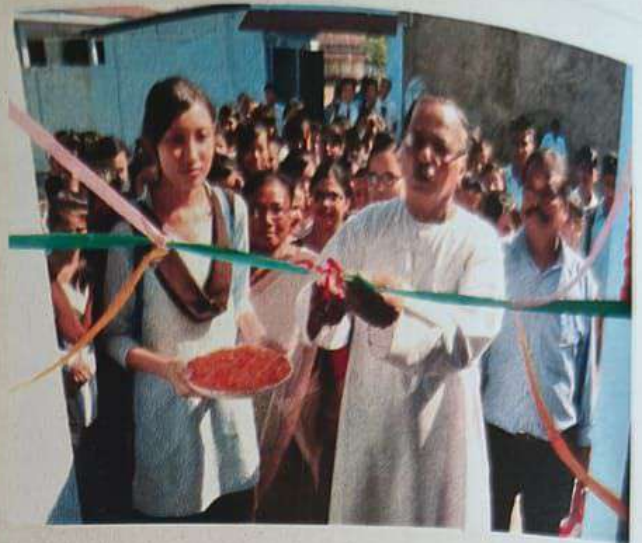

Fresher's Welcoming Programme (Nabin Baran Utsab) on 27th September, 2016



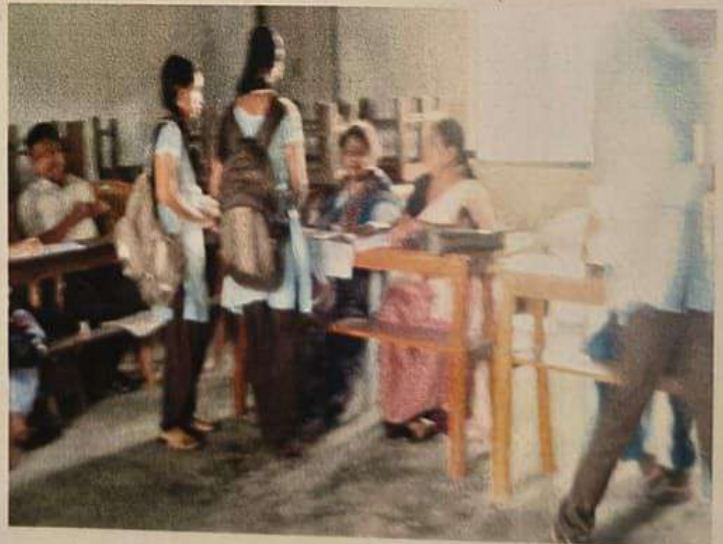
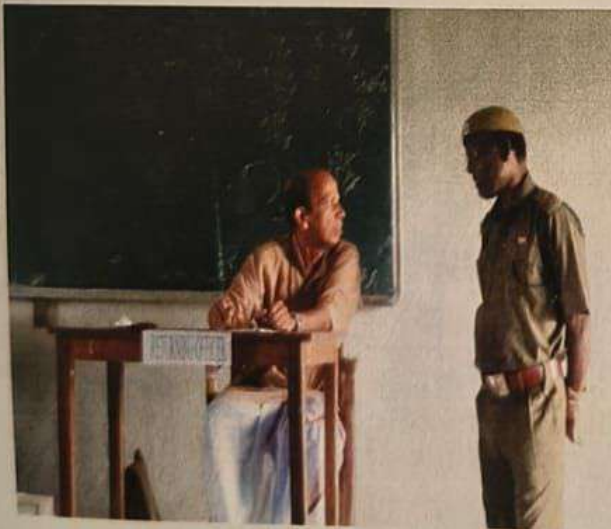

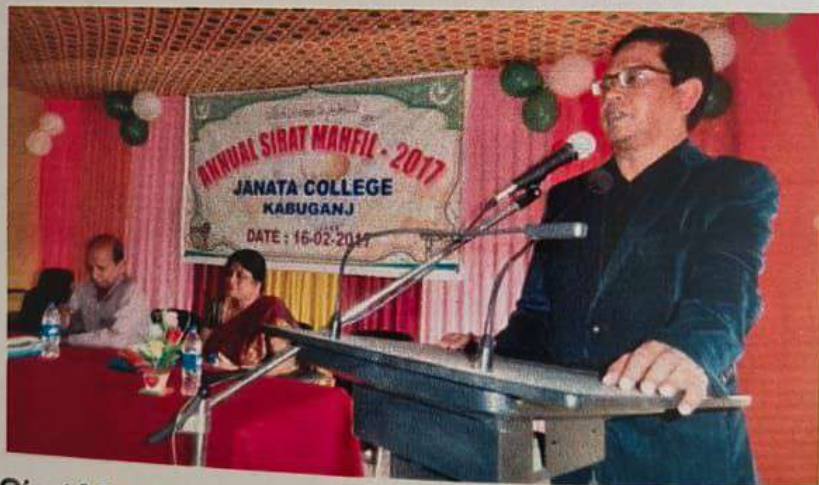


Blood Donation Camp on 14th February, 2017
